In Norway ferry lines are owned by the regions


Procurement of services used to be based on standard (polluting) technologies and cost competition

Call for tender which asked for new solutions



A good practice: Public procurement driving innovation



Procedure for procurement (entrepreneurial discovery process)

- Only to be used in calls for new services or products which are not in the market today.
- Set up an innovation partnership through negotiations.
- One or more supliers may be included in the partnership.
- R&D structured product development process in phases with clear milestones.
- Sunset clause, discover failures and terminate the contract to minimize loss of public money
