Northern Dimension Partnership in Public Health and Social Well-being (NDPHS)

- NDPHS is a partnership of the Northern Dimension (ND) Policy
- 10 partner countries and 9 partner organisations
- 7 Expert Groups to work on:
 - Reduced impact of HIV/AIDS, TB and associated infections
 - Contained antimicrobial resistance
 - Reduced impact of non-communicable diseases
 - Reduced social and health harm from alcohol, tobacco and illicit use of drugs
 - Adequately addressed health and social needs related to chronic conditions and demographic changes
 - Strengthened occupational safety and health and well-being at work
- NDPHS is the PA 'Health' Coordinator of the EUSBSR





NPDHS Activities

- High-level ministerial dialogue
- Monitoring and assessment of the situation in the region
- Development of policy recommendations
- Facilitation of coordinated development and implementation of regional projects
- Dissemination of information, outreach and involvement of relevant stakeholders
- Raising the profile of health and social-well being
