Engaging in the European debate on circular economy



Reduced human and environmental exposure to toxic chemicals in healthcare





- Raise awareness amongst policy-makers and the healthcare sector of toxic chemicals in healthcare
- Increase commitment of the healthcare sector in Europe to use safer medical devices
- Reduce the health and environmental impacts of i) chemical waste (with focus on plastics), and ii) disinfectants used by the European health sector



Climate change as a health issue: decarbonisation of the European healthcare sector and increased climate advocacy by healthcare leaders





- Network expansion: Expand direct healthcare climate action via network in Europe
- **Policy advocacy:** Pushing for more ambitious climate targets in Europe and integrate health care into climate policy and climate into health policy at the national and EU level
- Economic transformation: Accelerate the transition to a lowcarbon economy / Reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions across the European healthcare sector

SUSTAINABLE FOOD EUROPE





- **Strengthen policies** applicable to the provision of sustainable food in the healthcare sector
- Improve **sustainable food practices** in European healthcare
- Increase awareness about the economic/health/social/environment benefits of sustainable food







The EU has the 2nd place in terms of pharmaceuticals sales behind the US with an overall market estimated at €225 billion.

Reduced pharmaceuticals presence in the environment





- Advocate for increased transparency and improved consistency of pharmaceutical manufacturing throughout the supply chain
- Enable a reduction in pharmaceuticals discharged in the environment from animal farming and aquaculture
- Identify best management practices for wastewater at a manufacturing, municipal, and hospital level
- Increase awareness amongst healthcare professionals about overprescription practices and proper use of pharmaceuticals



SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT EUROPE







Leverage healthcare's purchasing and investment power to accelerate the transition to circular economy





- Strengthen sustainable procurement practice through increased access to information and awareness of best practices in sustainable procurement policy
- Increase market demand for responsible products
- Facilitate and coordinate healthcare to play a major role in implementation of the EU circular economy and plastics strategies
